



Case study: Eye trauma

Patient: The patient was presented with a very painful and swollen eye caused by bite wounds from another dog. Due to the extensive intraocular bleeding and swelling, the owner was warned of possible enucleation.

Treatment: Phototherapy was done once a day, for 3 minutes. The patient was kept on concurrent antibiotics and systemic anti-inflammatory drugs.

Outcome: After only 5 phototherapy sessions, the swelling, bleeding and pain had subsided completely and the patient was send home.
